

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

ISO14001 defines an environmental policy “as a statement by the organisation of its intentions and principles in relation to its overall environmental performance which provides a framework for action and for the setting of its environmental objectives and targets”.

St.Davids City Council recognises that an awareness of the environmental issues relevant to our operations should be a fundamental part of its business. The objective is to achieve a balance that addresses the needs of the business with the responsibilities required to gain recognition to formal Environmental Management Systems. St.Davids City Council will promote, wherever possible, its commitment to an environmentally caring future.

- St.Davids City Council will be aware of and comply with all legislation, present and impending that will impact upon the environmental position of the project.
- St.Davids City Council will actively seek to recycle all waste in the most suitable method possible. We will promote the use of segregation and reprocessing in waste generated from its activities.
- St.Davids City Council will, wherever technically possible and economically viable, source raw material that has minimal impact on the environment.
- St.Davids City Council are committed to the prevention of pollution and to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment.
- Through training and development, St.Davids City Council will ensure that our commitment to this policy will be fulfilled and will seek to continually improve upon aspects of our business in relation to environmental responsibilities.
- The Council will ensure that adequate resources and information is available to maintain the objectives set out in this policy. Management will be responsible for reviewing the policy and Environmental Management Programme annually to ensure that it is current and valid to business and environmental needs.
